# **1. Maintenance Basics**

## Oil changes:

Don't ignore this. Most Chevy engines hate old oil. Check your dipstick every month. If the oil's dark or gritty, change it

#### Tires:

Check air pressure once a week. Look at tread wear. Uneven wear? Might be alignment. Don't drive like it's fine. Buy a cheap tire gauge and actually use it.

#### **Brakes:**

Listen. Scraping, squealing, grinding? That's your car screaming for help. Pads are cheap; rotors cost more. Don't wait.

#### **Battery:**

Battery dies out of nowhere. Check terminals for corrosion. Clean with baking soda and water if needed. Keep jumper cables in the trunk.

#### Fluids:

Transmission, brake, coolant, windshield washer — all of it. Top off when low. Don't just assume "it's fine." Cars run on fluids; dry = bad news.



# 2. Controls You Actually Need to Know

### **Dashboard lights:**

They are not decorations. "Check Engine" = check it. Google the code or hit a mechanic.

#### Steering & handling:

If your car pulls left or right, don't fight it. Check tire pressure and alignment first.

## Infotainment / Bluetooth:

Don't be afraid to fiddle. Most Chevy units are touch-friendly, but the voice commands are hit-or-miss. Sometimes you just have to tap around.

#### **Cruise control:**

Amazing for highways, terrible for city traffic. Learn the on/off switches before you try using it.

#### Wipers & lights:

Super basic, but I see people struggle. High beams, fog lights, hazard lights — know where they are. Could save your life.



# 3. Safety Tips

#### **Seat belts:**

Not optional. Even a low-speed crash will mess you up.

### **Blind spots:**

Every car has them. Mirrors help, but always check over your shoulder.

## Airbags:

Don't mess with sensors or wiring. If the light is on, get it fixed.

### **Driving habits:**

Speed kills. Tailgating? Don't. Keep distance. Chevy can handle, but physics doesn't care what you drive.

### **Emergency kit:**

Flashlight, jumper cables, first aid, water, snacks. You'll thank yourself if you break down.
